Program Success (July 2010 - August 2023)

520

students participated in a work experience and have graduated from the program since 2010.



2,420

ELOs have been completed, 1,786 academic credits obtained with 384 additional credits gained through the computer lab.



379

students have already graduated from high school and 15 have earned their GED/HiSET.

Upon program completion, 99% of students reengaged with their education:

49 students graduated immediately upon completion of program.

19 students attended alternative education.

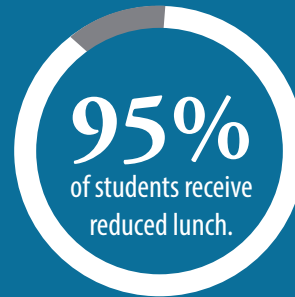
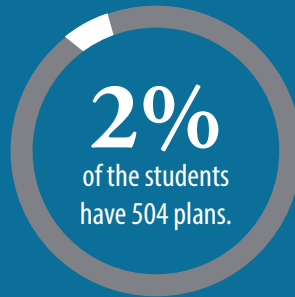
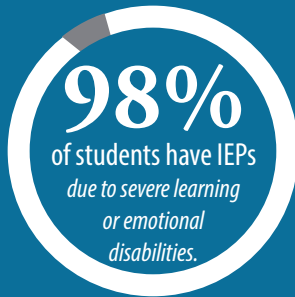
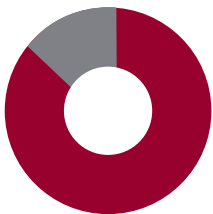
452 students returned to high school.

The Earn & Learn Opportunities Program provides Extended Learning Opportunities (ELOs) to students with disabilities who are at-risk of dropping out of high school.



The average student attendance rate is

94%



Two years after the program...

91% graduated from high school, obtained their GED/HiSet or are on track to graduate.

9% of students have moved or information is unknown.
