



IMPACCT PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Program Success (October 2016 - August 2023)

1,136
students participated in a work experience and have graduated from the program since 2016.

5,913
Extended Learning Opportunities have been completed, 3699.5 academic credits earned with 57.25 additional credits gained through the computer lab.

738
students graduated from high school following the program and 400 students are on the pathway to graduation.

Upon program completion, 99.8% of students reengaged with their education:

224 students graduated immediately.

859 students returned to high school.

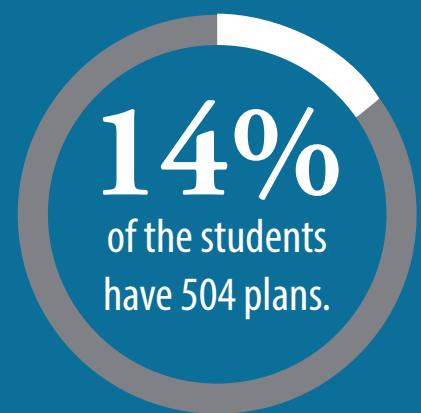
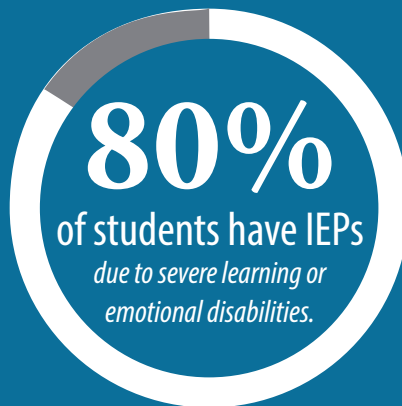
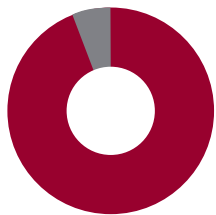
53 students attended alternative education.

The IMPACCT Program provides Extended Learning Opportunities (ELOs) to students with disabilities who are at-risk of dropping out of high school.

90%
