



Abbreviations used with legislation

LSR – Legislative Service Request - what a bill is called while it is being written.

OLS – Office of Legislative Services - a team of lawyers that writes the bill text for the legislators.

A – Amendment – a change to the bill has been from its original version.

FN – Fiscal Note - this means the bill has a financial component (like HB 10-FN)

HB – House Bill - a bill that is filed by a Representative.

SB – Senate Bill – a bill that is filed by a Senator

Committee Recommendations on bills

ITL – Inexpedient to Legislate – recommendation not to pass the bill

OTP – Ought to Pass – recommendation to pass

OTP-A – Ought to Pass with Amendment - recommendation to pass as the committee amended the bill

Hearing Locations

LOB – Legislative Office Building - where Committee rooms are located, and most hearings take place. It is located directly behind the State House.

SH – State House - State Capitol where NH House and Senate hold session to vote on bills
